The Lower Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors met on August 25, 2022 for their regular meeting. Clint Barick, Jake Fealtman, Frank Oiler were present. The meeting was called to order by CB 7:08pm. The minutes of the July 28, 2022 meeting were approved CB,JF,FO

**FIRE:** 17 calls for July Upcoming meeting for townships regarding a 10 year plan for the firehouse. Details to come

**PUBLIC:** RD brought up a complaint regarding 159/161 Roxbury Rd. He wants the properties cleaned up. JB stated that the one property had a house fire and has applied for a permit to repair the home. And that the family is going through a lot and could use some help and encourages those that can, reach out and help.

**SOLICITOR:** *Blue Mountain Heights* – contracts received are the ones needed. *2 Meadows Rd.* – motion by board to file for non-payment of trash service CB,JF,FO *19 Creekview Rd & 866 Center Rd.* – Board requests a letter be sent 866 Center regarding cleanup of the property. Brandi will try to get contact information for Wanda *447 Shed Rd* – No mowing has happened so civil complaint filed. Hearing scheduled for October 5, 2022 at 10:15am *830 DGR* – JB will contact Commonwealth Code regarding condemning the property being uninhabitable. *Garman Curative Amendment* – hearing is scheduled for Aug. 29, 2022 at 6:30pm. *Tax Collector* - Monica Miller has resigned as tax collector effective August 30, 2022. Board accepts resignation CB,JF,FO Bridget Burnhisel is willing to fulfill the tax collector position if the board approves. After some questions, Board appoints Bridget Burnhisel as interim tax collector effective September 2, 2022 after closeout by Monica Miller. CB,JF,FO Bridget asks that she be permitted to collect taxes at the township building when she sets office hours. CB,JF,FO

**ROADMASTER:** JF stated storm cleanup happened. Harvey bridge maintenance/cleanup will happen Aug. 30<sup>th</sup> Boom mower is available for purchase from Burky Implements. Board discussed purchase and how best to do it, decision was to purchase the boom mower from Burky using liquid fuels monies. Fuel tank needs to be replaced, quote requested from several companies, Messick's responded, and after some modifications to the quote, purchase will happen with our manual pump installed. CB,FO,JF Salt contract through WCCOG request sent.

**PLANNING:** *Kramer Plans* – Planning commission recommends the board sign the septic module and send to DEP for their review. Board agrees JF,CB,FO Plans will be reviewed in more detail at September 29 meeting.
