BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
June 26, 2025**

The Lower Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors met on June 26, 2025 for their regular meeting. Clint Barrick, Jake Fealtman, Frank Oiler were present. The meeting was called to order by CB at 7:02pm. The minutes of the May 29, 2025 meeting were approved CB,JF,FO

EMC: Still working on Letterkenny EAP. CC has the radios and are still looking at a Fall 2025 implementation

PUBLIC: Kelly Shughart asked if the township would send the acknowledgement letter to PennDOT for the minimum use driveway that she would like to put at the Center Rd lot. BOS motion to send acknowledgement letter CB,JF,FO

SOLICITOR: *1482 Center Rd* – constable still needing to collect judgement
524 Shed Rd – Still working on determining status of the mortgage – not much luck so far
85 Asper Rd – working on filing against the property for failure to obtain proper permitting and ROW

ROADMASTER/ASST. ROADMASTER: DJ mowing & weedwacking are happening Bridge Inspections were done on Pipeline, Rock Run, Harvey & Blain McCrea. Driveways on Shed Rd at Sunset, Nailor & Vista Lanes are washing out onto the roadway badly. This is causing a safety issue for the roads. DJ will reach out to the homeowners, and if necessary we will send a letter to each property owner on the lanes. PEOTG was approved to do tree removal on Creekview up to \$2000.00 Creekview Bridge deck replacement had a meeting with Brehm-Lebo regarding some concerns that are coming up with the plans and communication. Engineer will address these issues. Rock Run Rd Grant was denied for 2025 but we will reapply for 2026.
