BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING**

June 27, 2024

The Lower Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors met on June 27, 2024 for their regular meeting. Clinton Barrick, Frank Oiler, & Jake Fealtman were present. The meeting was called to order by CB at 7:02pm. The minutes of the May 30, 2024 meeting were approved CB,JF,FO

PUBLIC: Lori Whitmer/Marcia Leatherman asked about putting a driveway in on Shed Road at their property and asked what the requirements were. SG gave an FPR update.

ROADMASTER: Tar & Chip bids received \$35,408.70 Wilson Paving; \$48,818.50 Midland Asphalt; \$29,874.48 Russell Standard; \$26,280.21 Kough’s

After discussion and review of the bids – board awarded the bid to Kough’s JF,CB,FO Greg Lebo is looking into the structural integrity of the Creekview Rd bridge to determine the next steps in repair/replacement. There was an inspection done at Creekview without notice. Road mowing has been completed – Thank you to the road crew for their commitment to our township! Road Leveling & Widening project \$156,561.65 awarded to Schlusser’s JF,CB,FO (*as noted in the May 30, 2024 minutes*)

ZONING: 4 permits for June \$183.00 fees

19 Creekview – JB reviewed the Zoning book for clarification and Mr. Righi is in violation with what he is using the property for in the district that the property is in. He will need to have a conditional use hearing to outline what he is doing with the property so that the board can stipulate guidelines. MM will send a letter outlining the violations he has at this time and his refusal to comply with the simple request that the board had made at the March 2024 meeting, and let him know about the conditional use hearing.
