The Lower Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors met on June 30, 2022 for their regular meeting. Clint Barrick, Jake Fealtman, Frank Oiler were present. The meeting was called to order by Clint Barrick 7:02pm. The minutes of the May 26, 2022 were approved CB,JF,FO

FO brought to attention that grant project that was completed at 60 Pipeline needs to have the rocks looked at, possible repair needed.
