PUBLIC: SG drafted a letter to be sent to legislatures regarding changing/updating the regulations on the spreading of FPR wastes. If anyone is interested in a letter, he will have copies to hand out. Carl Goshorn, Kirk Stoner, & Chaz Heberlig were in attendance from County to discuss some items that the board has had concerns about. CC also offered to work with municipalities to draft options for regulation of the application of FPR wastes.

Board asks that MM proceed with filing a civil case against Mr. Gutshall CB,JF,FO JB states that LMT has multiple fines for the many violations "Renny" is facing. 490 Shed Rd. – letter sent from MM waiting on ROW agreement from owner 447 Shed Rd. – potential sale of the property so any issue is on hold until sale is completed. 338 DGR – civil court date is set for May 31, 2023 at 11:30am JB did an inspection and will present his findings at the hearing. 830 DGR – will remain and move forward on the blighted property with County since no action has been taken after permit issued. Zoning Book Update – some items needing immediate action will be presented for next month after John & Matt discuss items. John will get items together and discuss with Matt & Brandi and then do a workshop to outline changes needed to present to County.
