

**LOWER MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
October 29, 2025**

The Lower Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors met on October 29, 2025 for their regular meeting. Clint Barrick, Jake Fealtman, Frank Oiler were present. The meeting was called to order by CB at 7:02pm. The minutes of the September 25, 2025 meeting were approved CB,JF,FO

PUBLIC: Resident concerned about the shooting range on Asper Rd. He feels that LMT is permitting something that they should be “shutting down” CB stated that the resident did what was asked of him by applying for a conditional use, however the owner of the property said that the private shooting range will end 12/31/2025. The hearing cannot happen in that amount of time. The BOS is taking the owners word that things will cease the end of the year. The resident feels that this is unacceptable and was very upset. SG reported that the FPR regulations passed the House of Representatives which is a step in the right direction. Data centers are a concern in many townships and we need to be vigilant in getting regulations set up in LMT regarding them.

SOLICITOR: Zito contract completed with an increase to 5% on the franchise fee in LMT CB,JF,FO JB asks to cancel hearing with 500 Shed due to resident being in compliance at this time. 1 Meadows hearing will stand on 11/12/2025 Lay/Fealtman waiver is ready to sign

PLANNING: Oiler plan submitted – no concerns with plan – approved CB, JF FO abstained
Center Rd lot reviewed plans, PC and Zoning request additional information before proceeding: SEO design plan showing swail & impervious areas, 20’ driveway, CC engineer noting an area that is designated at “wetland”, drainage run off, placement of well with neighbors septic, and vice versa. There are neighbor concerns as well with water in their basement, as well as the distances with the neighboring well & septic and run offs. Twp. will send Henry & Shughart a list of the additional information needed.

ROADMASTER/ASST. ROADMASTER: DJ reported that weed wacking & line painting have been completed. Inspections done on equipment. Rust prevention will be done 11/10/2025 Sunset & Nailor have done some work to deter the runoff onto township road. Time will tell if the repair worked. PennDOT traffic study will be done on Center Rd. Once that is completed then ordinance can continue.
