

**LOWER MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
September 29, 2022**

The Lower Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors met on September 29, 2022 for their regular meeting. Clint Barick, Jake Fealtman, Frank Oiler were present. The meeting was called to order by CB 7:01pm. The minutes of the August 25, 2022 meeting were approved JF,FO,CB

FIRE: Fire report was presented to the board, but no representative from FHC was present

PUBLIC: 314 Doubling Gap Road is asking for a waiver to build a larger shed on his property. He is removing the old one that is 5' from the rear property line. Board asks that he place the new shed 10' from the property line as a compromise since he has limited space to work with. CB,JF,FO Brandi will send a letter with the Board's decision outlined.

SOLICITOR: *2 Meadows Rd.* – hearing is scheduled for November 9 @10:15am for non-payment of trash bill
866 Center Rd. – Property is owned by Wanda Mixell, board requests that Brandi contact Wanda again requesting a sit down to discuss the property and an outline on cleanup. *447 Shed Rd* – Hearing is scheduled for Oct, 11, 2022 at 1:30pm JB will represent LMT with MM handling the case.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT: 8 permits this month \$655.50 fees 830 DGR – Board is moving forward with the condemnation of the property through the Cumberland County's Blighted Property program CB,JF,FO JB requests a site visit with the board at 336 & 338 DGR due to continuous violations of the zoning ordinance.

ROADMASTER: JF stated he and the road crew are pleased with the boom mower purchase. Harvey bridge maintenance/cleanup is completed. Tar & chip has been done on sections of Middle, Rock Run, Mountain, Shed, & Mohawk. Special needs sign needed for Conifer Rd. Brandi ordered. "unofficial" pricing for COG salt bid for 2022/2023 season has been sent out to members. Still are able to purchase at last year's pricing – Roadmaster would like to order 1 load of salt (*25ton*)

PLANNING: Kramer Plans – Waiting on response from DEP regarding septic module submission. Plans need to show septic easement and ROW agreement. Kramer allows a 60 day extension for those things to be completed. CB,JF,FO
