

**LOWER MIFFLIN TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING
September 30, 2021**

The Lower Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors met on September 30, 2021 for their regular meeting. Clint Barrick, Jake Fealtman, Frank Oiler were present. CB called the meeting to order at 7:07pm. The minutes of the August 26, 2021 board meeting and the September 8, 2021 hearing & workshop were approved CB,JF,FO

EMC: attended a SkyWarn class. Discussed with county adding properties to the hazard mitigation plan. No resolution necessary to add a property. WEMA bought a new truck, but has lost their main fundraiser.

SOLICITOR’S REPORT: 962 Doubling Gap Rd – MM stated that a letter received from surveyor which provides an analysis of the property means there is no need to have DEP do an inspection on the stream distance with the proposed addition. No need for a 50’ ROW from the stream due to the analysis. Being that the proposed addition is only 14’ 10” from the property line, and does not meet the setback requirements, a variance will be needed.

Planning Commission alternate appointed: Chairman Clinton Barrick will serve as an alternate JF,FO (CB abstained)

ROADMASTER: Closed roads for the storms that we had. Surveyor drawings for Hunter Rd obtained – will meet with Gordon Holl to discuss the plans. Wire hanging @ Harvey Rd due to storm needs to be looked into. Should be Centurylink. Brandi will call and see if anything will be done.

PLANNING COMMISSION: Foster Subdivision: Note on the plans needs to show that the business cannot be used as an expansion or addition to the existing business. Once changes submitted plans may be signed CB,JF,FO
Mixell Subdivision – Plans were submitted for final approval. This subdivision is only for property NORTH of the turnpike. CB,JF,FO Mixell attorney will send an inspection report from DEP that was issued to Mixell in mid July. LMT is asking that the property where the junkyard used to be be cleaned up ASAP **Ditzler Subdivision** – shared driveway agreement received. Comments were addressed plan approved JF,CB,FO
