The Lower Mifflin Township Board of Supervisors met on September 8, 2021 for an discussion on a property maintenance ordinance workshop. A public hearing for Ordinance 2021-01 was also held. Clint Barrick, Jake Fealtman, Frank Oiler were present. The meeting was called to order by CB at 6:11pm

ORDINANCE 2021-01 HEARING: Trash collection & Recycling Ordinance for Residential Properties within Lower Mifflin Township Public hearing was opened to the floor for anyone to ask questions or make comments – there were none. Ordinance 2021-01 approved JF,CB,FO

ADMINISTRATIVE: Letters will be sent to all residents outlining the Trash Collection & Recycling program by September 10, 2021 to allow residents the option to sign up for full service, senior full service, recycling only, bag service, or an exemption by September 16, 2021. Trash collection will start within LMT November 1, 2021

ORDINANCE DISCUSSION: Supervisors discussed items to be included in a Property Maintenance Code to go along with the Zoning Book that LMT has in place. After much discussion the decision by the board was to put these items into the current Zoning Book for LMT adopted November 17, 2020 as amendments to simplify the need for multiple books. MM and MattM will work on adding amendments to the Zoning Book to be due November 10, 2021 to the board for review.
